

Evaluating Limits

Evaluate each limit.

1) $\lim_{x \rightarrow -1} 5$

2) $\lim_{x \rightarrow -\frac{5}{2}} (-x + 2)$

3) $\lim_{x \rightarrow 2} (x^3 - x^2 - 4)$

4) $\lim_{x \rightarrow 1} \left(-\frac{x^2}{2} + 2x + 4 \right)$

5) $\lim_{x \rightarrow 3} -\sqrt{x + 3}$

6) $\lim_{x \rightarrow \frac{3}{2}} -\sqrt{2x + 4}$

7) $\lim_{x \rightarrow 1} \frac{x - 4}{x^2 - 6x + 8}$

8) $\lim_{x \rightarrow \frac{3}{2}} \frac{-x - 3}{x^2 + x + 1}$

9) $\lim_{x \rightarrow \pi} \sin(x)$

10) $\lim_{x \rightarrow \frac{3\pi}{4}} 2\cos(x)$
